- 3. What scene, if any, would you change?
- 4. What did you like the best about the protagonist, Anastasia Day?
- 5. What did you like about Charlene and Natalia? What are your thoughts about Blake and Nate?
- 6. How are some characters similar and how are they different?
- 7. What character(s) could you identify with and why?
- 8. Which character(s), if any, frustrated you and why?
- 9. Name each female character and her experience of motherhood if any.
- 10. Do you think the book captured varying emotions surrounding motherhood?
- 11. Would you say Ana's "revenue revitalization plan" (renting rooms) was successful or dead?
- 12. Would you have helped Rebecca and Bella as Ana and her roommates did or done something different or nothing at all?
- 13. What messages do you think haunt women? Are the messages that haunt women today different than the 1800s? How so?
- 14. Did you learn something new about women's history, religion, relationships, or something else from the novel?
- 15. Have you ever fostered an animal (or human) or volunteered anywhere? Would you do so again?
- 16. The characters exhibit a variety of spiritual journeys or lack thereof. Which character's spiritual journey best replicates your own spiritual path?
- 17. What message or theme of the novel did you find meaningful and why?
- 18. Was there a part of the novel you found thought-provoking?
- 19. Did this novel make you want to explore the real City of York, Pennsylvania and/or another place discussed in the novel?
- 20. What scares you more: the living or the dead?
- 21. Have you ever experienced something supernatural or spooky?
- 22. Do you believe in ghosts or an afterlife of sorts?
- 23. Would you recommend this book? Why or why not?
